8 EASY THINGS TO DO

To Help Your Community

VOTE NOVEMBER 4

Too late to launch a massive voter registration drive? Looking for some easy last-minute ways to get involved over the next 3 weeks? Here's a sheet of simple, low cost, tried and true ways your nonprofit can boost voter participation during these last 4 weeks before Election Day.

- 1 **SIGN UP POLL MONITORS** or Poll Workers: Use Poll Monitor Link at www.nonprofitvote.org. Go to Pollworkers for Democracy - <http://act.credoaction.com/pollworkers/index.html>
- 2 **800 VOTER HELP LINES:** These English and Spanish voter assistance lines are staffed for all 50 states. 1-866-OUR VOTE and 1-888-Ve-Y-Vota. Promote them in emails, cards, posters and more.
- 3 **ADD PAYROLL STUFFER.** Put a Vote November 4 message to your next payroll envelope. Samples on our website – under Checklists and Tools
- 4 **HELP PEOPLE VOTE EARLY** by Mail or In-Person at an Early Voting Site. Use these GoVote links. For Early Voting: www.govote.org. Vote-by-Mail: www.govoteabsentee.org. Or call your election office today to learn more!
- 5 **FIND YOUR POLL** for You and Your Community. Go to www.vote411.org – hosted by the League of Women Voters
- 6 **WALK, RIDE OR DRIVE** to the Polls. Organize a nonpartisan group vote – walk or ride to the polls together. Or tell voters to call the candidate of their choice – campaigns offer rides
- 7 **GET VOTER GUIDES AND SAMPLE BALLOTS.** Download, view, or print nonpartisan voter guides from all 50 states – from your Secretary of State, League of Women Voters and more
- 8 **MAKE ELECTION DAY “DEMOCRACY DAY”.** Roll out the bunting! Make this Election Day a celebration of democracy.
