



NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET ARIZONA



VOTER FAQs:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- **How Old Do I Need to Be?** 18 years-old or older on or before the day of the next regular General Election
- **Can I Register Online?** Yes, if you have a state or tribal ID
- **I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register?** Automatic restoration after completion of sentence for single felony conviction. For two or more felony convictions, you must petition the court to restore their rights.
- **I Am Homeless, How Do I Register?** Describe location using mileage, cross streets, landmarks, etc. and Draw a map and/or provide latitude/longitude where you may be found in the provided box on the voter registration form
- **Where Do I Register in Person?** You may visit your County Recorder's Office and fill out a registration form in person.
- **Is there a residency requirement?** Yes, you must be a resident of Arizona and the county listed on your registration
- **Do I need ID to register in-person?** Yes, an Arizona driver license or some proof of citizenship

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- **Do I Need ID to Vote?** Yes, a valid ID issued by any state or a tribal ID. See Voter ID needs for more.
- **When Can I Vote?** See the Important Dates.
- **Where Can I Find My Polling Place?** See the State Voter Portal.
- **I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me?**
Yes, curbside voting is available. All polling locations and vote centers must have an accessible voting device for use by voters with disabilities

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- **Who Can Vote By Mail?** Any registered voter, no excuses needed
- **How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot?** You can apply for a one-time ballot by mail, fax, email, or online, or you can also apply for the Active Early Voting List (AEVL) by mail, fax, email or online in Maricopa County.
- **How Do I Return My Ballot?** By mail (pre-paid) or in-person dropbox
- **When is My Ballot Due?** Received by 7pm on election day
- **How Do I Track My Ballot?** See State Voter Portal
- **I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance?** Yes, you can designate a family member, person living in the same household, or caregiver to request and/or return your ballot. You can also request to be on permanent early voter list



IMPORTANT DATES

Early Voting Period: Oct 12 – Nov 7
Election date: Nov 8
Registration deadline: Oct 11
Vote by Mail request deadline: Oct 28
