



NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET NEW JERSEY



VOTER FAQs:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- **How Old Do I Need to Be?** At least 17 years old, though you may not vote until you have reached the age of 18
- **Can I Register Online?** Yes, if you have a state-issued license or ID.
- **I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register?** Any person who is no longer in prison, or on parole or probation can register to vote
- **I Am Homeless, How Do I Register?** List a contact point (like cross streets or building address) for the place you spend most of your time
- **Where Do I Register in Person?** Go to the County Commissioner of Registration or Superintendent of Elections for your county
- **Is there a residency requirement?** You must be resident of State and county 30 days before the election
- **Do I need ID to register in-person?** No, but ID will be required when voting if no valid identification showing name and address is shown

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- **Do I Need ID to Vote?** Only if identification was not provided during registration or if information provided could not be verified
- **When Can I Vote?** See the Important Dates.
- **Where Can I Find My Polling Place?** See the State Voter Portal.
- **I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me?**
Yes, polling places are accessible but you make make a report if there are concerns

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- **Who Can Vote By Mail?** Registered voters can apply for a vote-by-mail ballot
- **How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot?** Download and fill out the application and return it by mail or in person to the County Clerks
- **How Do I Return My Ballot?** By mail or in-person drop off at the Board of Elections office or Secure Ballot Drop Box
- **When is My Ballot Due?** Postmark no later than 8 pm election day or in-person on election day by 8 pm
- **How Do I Track My Ballot?** See Track your Ballot.
- **I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance?** Yes, you may designate a "Bearer" who must sign the "Bearer Portion" of the outer envelope of the ballot in the presence of the voter.



IMPORTANT DATES

Early Voting Period: Oct 29 – Nov 6

Election date: Nov 8

Registration deadline: Oct 18

Vote by Mail request deadline: Nov 1
