



NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET MICHIGAN



VOTER FAQs:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- **How Old Do I Need to Be?** At least 18 years-old by Election day
- **Can I Register Online?** Yes, if you have a state issued license or ID
- **I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register?** You are eligible to register if not currently serving a sentence in jail or prison
- **I Am Homeless, How Do I Register?** List a shelter address as their voting address on voter registration form. Use a street corner or a park address on voter registration form. List an address where you receive mail.
- **Where Do I Register in Person?** At your local clerk's office, Secretary of State offices, and military recruitment centers
- **Is there a residency requirement?** Yes, you must be a resident of the state and the county/township for 30 days before you vote
- **Do I need ID to register in-person?** Yes, acceptable forms are a state-issued ID, current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, etc with your current address

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- **Do I Need ID to Vote?** Bring a state issued ID, otherwise you can sign an affidavit and still vote
- **When Can I Vote?** See the Important Dates.
- **Where Can I Find My Polling Place?** See the State Voter Portal.
- **I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me?** Yes, polling places are accessible

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- **Who Can Vote By Mail?** Any registered voter, no reasons needed
- **How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot?** Apply online or download an application to return by mail or in person to your local clerk or township.
- **How Do I Return My Ballot?** By mail or in-person drop off. You may need to pay for postage.
- **When is My Ballot Due?** Received by 8pm on Election Day
- **How Do I Track My Ballot?** See the State Voter Portal.
- **I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance?** Yes, you can apply for an accessible absent voter ballot

Absentee Early Voting Period:
Sep 29 - Nov 7

Election date: Nov 8

Registration deadline: Oct 24

Vote by Mail request deadline: Nov 4
