



# NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET INDIANA



## VOTER FAQs:

### WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- **How Old Do I Need to Be?** 18 years-old by Election Day
- **Can I Register Online?** Yes, if you have a state issued ID, otherwise register on paper
- **I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register?** Yes, voting rights are restored after release
- **I Am Homeless, How Do I Register?** Use the address or cross streets for wherever you sleep
- **Where Do I Register in Person?** Voter registration or county clerk's office, any BMV license branch if obtaining license or ID, public assistance office if applying for service or assistance.
- **Is there a residency requirement?** Yes, you must live in the precinct for at least 30 days
- **Do I need ID to register in-person?** Yes, you can provide either State ID, license or social security number

### WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- **Do I Need ID to Vote?** Yes. It must be a IN or federally issued ID that includes your name, photo, and not expired on or before Nov 3, 2020
- **When Can I Vote?** Check with your county elections office for hours of early voting. Polls are open on Election Day from 6am to 6pm
- **Where Can I Find My Polling Place?** See the State Voter Portal
- **I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me?** Yes, polling places are accessible. Accessible voting machine available. May designate own assistant or be assisted by poll worker

### WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- **Who Can Vote By Mail?** Must have an excuse, like disability, illness, being out of town, working, or not having transportation. Select the reason that applies on the request form
- **How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot?** Online, mail (postage required), email or in-person
- **How Do I Return My Ballot?** In-person or by mail (postage required)
- **When is My Ballot Due?** Recieved by noon on November 8
- **How Do I Track My Ballot?** Use the state voter portal
- **I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance?** Yes, someone may assist you with requesting a mail ballot..

*Early Voting Period:* Oct 11 – Nov 7

*Election date:* Nov 8

*Registration deadline:* Oct 11

*Vote by Mail request deadline:* Oct 27
