



NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET KENTUCKY



VOTER FAQs:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- **How Old Do I Need to Be?** You may register to vote in Kentucky as a 17-year-old if you will be 18 years old by the next General Election
- **Can I Register Online?** Yes, you can update or register for the first time online
- **I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register?** Your voting rights may have been restored, check your status at <https://secure.kentucky.gov/Corrections/VoterEligibility/search>
- **I Am Homeless, How Do I Register?** Provide an address for where you sleep at night for residence and a mailing address where you collect mail (can be a P.O. box)
- **Where Do I Register in Person?** Obtain a voter registration card at your county clerk's office, complete and return it to your county clerk
- **Is there a residency requirement?** Yes, must be a resident for at least 28 days before the Election

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- **Do I Need ID to Vote?** No, except for first-time voters
- **When Can I Vote?** See the Important Dates.
- **Where Can I Find My Polling Place?** See the State Voter Portal
- **I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me?** Yes, polling places are accessible and you may request assistance

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- **Who Can Vote By Mail?** Only voters who cannot vote in person due to age, disability, temporarily living out of state (or county if a student), or out of county for all in-person voting hours.
- **How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot?** Apply online. You will need your social security number. Voters unable to use the state voter portal can call their county clerk for an accessible option
- **How Do I Return My Ballot?** By mail (postage required) or at a drop box in your county
- **When is My Ballot Due?** Ballots must be received by the county clerk by 6pm on Election Day
- **I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance?** You may designate someone to help you



IMPORTANT DATES

Early Voting Period: Nov 3 – 5

Election date: Nov 8 (closes at 6 pm)

Registration deadline: Oct 11 at 4pm

Vote by Mail request deadline: Oct 25
