

NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET MINNESOTA



VOTER FAQS:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- How Old Do I Need to Be? At least 18 years-old by Election day
- Can I Register Online? Yes, you will need either a Minnesota ID number or the last four of your social security number
- I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register? Yes, you can vote after you finish all parts of your sentence
- I Am Homeless, How Do I Register? You can use the location of where you sleep as your address. You may need to go to the polling place with someone who can confirm where you are living
- Where Do I Register in Person? You can register to vote at your polling location on Election Day or at your Early Voting location
- Is there a residency requirement? Yes, you must be a resident of Minnesota for 20 days
- Do I need ID to register in-person? Only if you are registering when you vote at the polling place

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING IN-PERSON?

- Do I Need ID to Vote? No, except for first-time voters
- When Can I Vote? See the Important Dates.
- Where Can I Find My Polling Place? See the State Voter Portal
- I Have a Disability, Are Polling Places Accessible to Me? Yes, polling places are accessible

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- Who Can Vote By Mail? Any voter, you do not have to be registered
- How Do I Apply for a Vote By Mail Ballot? Online form, mail (postage required), email or fax
- How Do I Return My Ballot? By mail (postage required) or in-person drop off
- When is My Ballot Due? Delivered in person no later than 3 p.m. on Election Day or received by mail on Election Day. You may not drop your ballot off at your polling place
- How Do I Track My Ballot? See Track Your Ballot
- I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance? You can request a braille ballot and/ or request an agent to deliver the ballot for you.



Early Voting Period: Sep 23 – Nov 7
Election date: Nov 8

Registration deadline: N/A

Vote by Mail request deadline: Nov 7
