

NONPROFIT VOTE STATE FACT SHEET **OREGON**



VOTER FAQS:

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW TO BE REGISTERED TO VOTE?

- How Old Do I Need to Be? At least 16 years-old to register, but you must be 18 by Election day to be sent a ballot
- Can I Register Online? Yes, if you have a state-issued ID you can complete
 the process online, otherwise you can print, sign, and deliver the form to your
 county elections office
- I Have a Felony Record, Can I Still Register? Yes, you can re-register after being discharged from prison
- I Am Homeless, How Do I Register? Use the address for wherever you sleep, including parks, shelters, etc. Homeless voters can pick up their ballot from the county election office
- Where Do I Register in Person? At the county elections office
- Is there a residency requirement? Yes, you must be a resident of the state and the county/township for 21 days before you vote

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT VOTING BY MAIL?

- Who Can Vote By Mail? Every registered voter is mailed a ballot at least two weeks before the election
- How Do I Return My Ballot? By mail (postage paid) or in-person drop off at a drop box
- When is My Ballot Due? Received by 8pm on November 8
- How Do I Track My Ballot? See the state voter portal
- I Have a Disability, Can I Use Assistance? Get assistance by calling your county elections office

Election date: Nov 8

Registration deadline: Oct 18
