

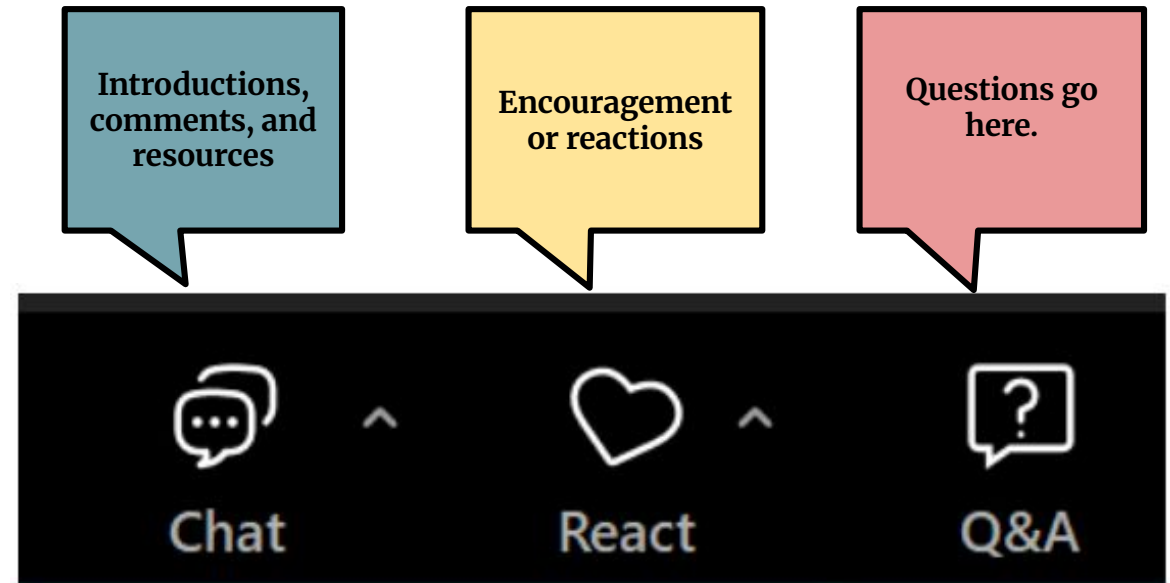

## Who is **Nonprofit VOTE**?

**Mission:** Nonprofit VOTE equips our nation's nonprofits with nonpartisan tools and resources to help the communities they serve participate in voting and democracy.

**Vision:** We envision a diverse network of nonprofits across the United States with the skills, resources, and commitment needed to foster a **more inclusive democracy** where all voices are heard, particularly those currently underrepresented in the voting process.

## What is the SAVE Act and how does it impact nonprofits?

- The SAVE America Act (formerly just SAVE Act) stands for “Safeguarding American Voter Eligibility.”
- Stated intention is to prevent non-citizens from voting.
- Current law already states that only citizens can vote
- Most common documents people use for ID do not provide proof of citizenship (driver’s license, REAL ID, student ID, utility bill...etc)
- To provide an acceptable ID, additional financial and time burden on voters
- Nonprofits and other organizations with a track record of successfully registering voters will have to teach people these new laws and help them get access to IDs, taking away time they could be doing other voter education.
- No funding allocation to agencies to process additional paperwork
