

VOTER REGISTRATION IN WYOMING

Wyoming does not allow third-party registration or voter registration drives. County clerks may not accept batches of voter registration applications.

✓ VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

- Applications must be received 14 days before Election Day (Same Day Registration is also available).

HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN WYOMING

Register to Vote in Person: Voters may register to vote in the office of the county clerk or town clerk within their county of residence. Voters may also print out a Wyoming Voter Registration Form and hand deliver the form to the county clerk in their county of residence. The form must be signed in front of the county clerk, and acceptable proof of identity, U.S. citizenship, and Wyoming residency must be submitted. Register by Mail: Voters may register to vote by mail. Applicants must sign their completed forms before a Registry Agent or person authorized to administer oaths (for example, a notary). Applicants must also include copies of acceptable proof of identity, U.S. citizenship, and Wyoming residency when mailing the completed and signed application to their local county clerk's office.

Register at the Polls: Wyoming allows same day registration at the polls during the absentee voting period or on Election Day. Bring the same ID as listed above. If a voter does not have all the required documentation, the voter will be offered a provisional ballot and have until the end of the next day to present proper ID to the county clerk.

OBTAINING APPLICATIONS

State Form: Voters may print out a Wyoming Voter Registration Form online from the Secretary of State's website and must follow the procedures in this guide to submit the form to the county clerk of their county of residence. Federal Form: Wyoming does not accept the National Mail Voter Registration Form.

ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS

In addition to **proof of identity**, documentary **proof of United States citizenship** and **proof of Wyoming residence** must be submitted when registering to vote. Bring these documents with you if registering in person, or include copies with your completed application if registering by mail. A current valid Wyoming driver's license, provided it does not contain any indication that you are not a U.S. citizen, satisfies all three requirements. If you do not have your current valid Wyoming driver's license with you, you must provide the number and additional acceptable identification as noted below. To satisfy Wyoming's proof of citizenship requirement, you may use your Wyoming driver's license, provided it does not contain any indication that you are not a U.S. citizen. If you have not been issued a Wyoming driver's license or yours is expired, you must provide the last four digits of your Social Security Number and additional acceptable identification as noted below. If you have neither a valid Wyoming driver's license nor a Social Security number, please indicate this by checking the appropriate box on the Voter Registration Form, and contact your county clerk.

ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS (CONTINUED)

Proof of Identity:

- Any **one** of the following:
 - Wyoming driver's license
 - U.S. Passport
 - Out-of-state driver's license
 - Military ID
 - Tribal ID
 - ID card issued by local, state, or federal agency
 - Wyoming student photo ID
- **OR** Any **two** or more of the following:
 - Certificate of U.S. citizenship or naturalization
 - Draft record
 - Voter registration card from out-of state
 - Void or temporary Wyoming driver's license
 - Social Security card
 - Original or certified copy of birth certificate
 - Any other form of ID issued by official agency

Proof of United States Citizenship:

- Any **one** of the following:
 - * Wyoming driver's license
 - * Wyoming ID
 - * Tribal ID
 - * Out-of-state driver's license
 - U.S. Passport
 - Certificate of U.S. citizenship or naturalization
 - Draft record
 - U.S. Dep't of State consular report of birth abroad
 - Original or certified copy of U.S. birth certificate

* Provided that it does not contain any indication that you are not a U.S. citizen.

Proof of Residency (must list a Wyoming address):

- Any **one** of the following:
 - Wyoming driver's license
 - U.S. Passport
 - Military ID
 - Tribal ID
 - ID card issued by local, state, or federal agency
 - Wyoming student ID
- **OR** Any **one** of the following that is dated **within 90 days** from the date of registration:
 - Utility bill
 - Bank statement
 - Government check or pay stub
 - Mortgage statement
 - Wyoming student housing verification
 - Any government document containing the applicant's name and address
- **OR** Any **one** of the following that is dated **within 1 year** from the date of registration:
 - Residential lease
 - Contract / intake document from a residential care facility
 - Wyoming property tax receipt
 - Wyoming hunting or fishing license
 - Wyoming vehicle registration
 - Communication on letterhead from a social service agency verifying homelessness and attesting to applicant's residence

If a person does not have the documents or other proof of residency specified by rule of the secretary of state, proof of residence may be established by attestation.
